

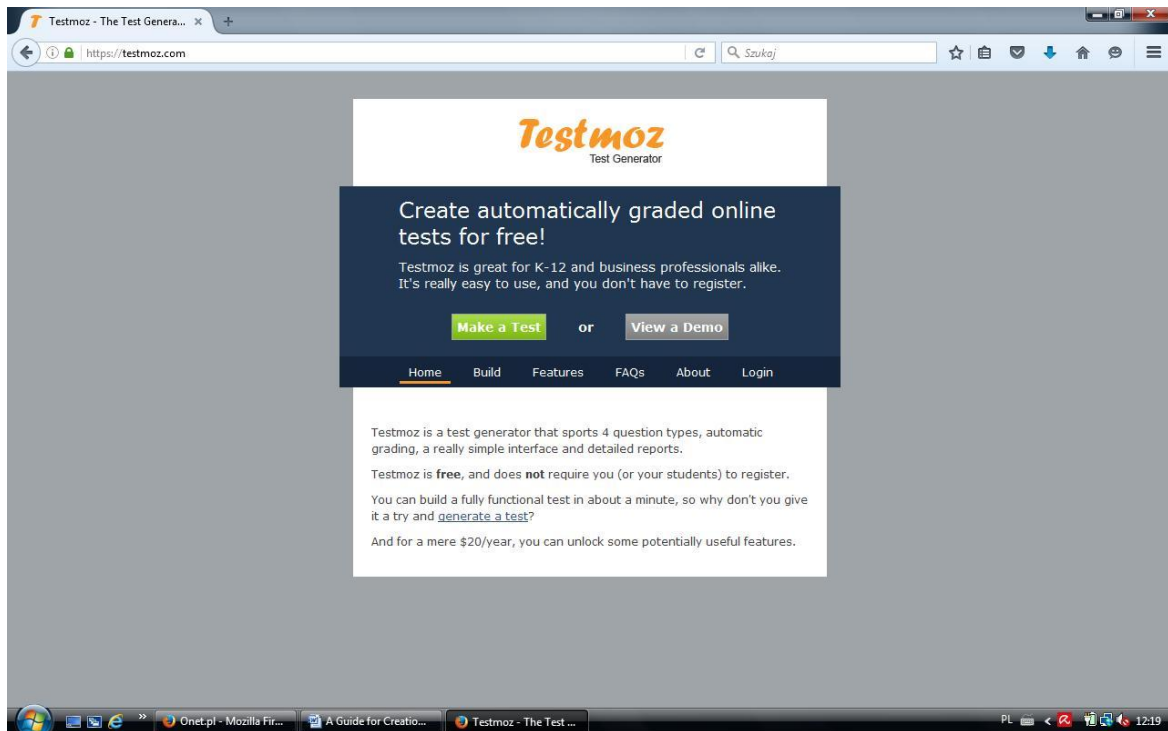
A Guide for Creation of Interactive Practice Tests

testmoz.com

Testmoz.com is one of the tools teachers can use during their classes. It is a very useful website that will enable both the students and the teachers to enjoy the learning-teaching experience. The following guide presents a step-by-step instructions of how to create online tests for students.

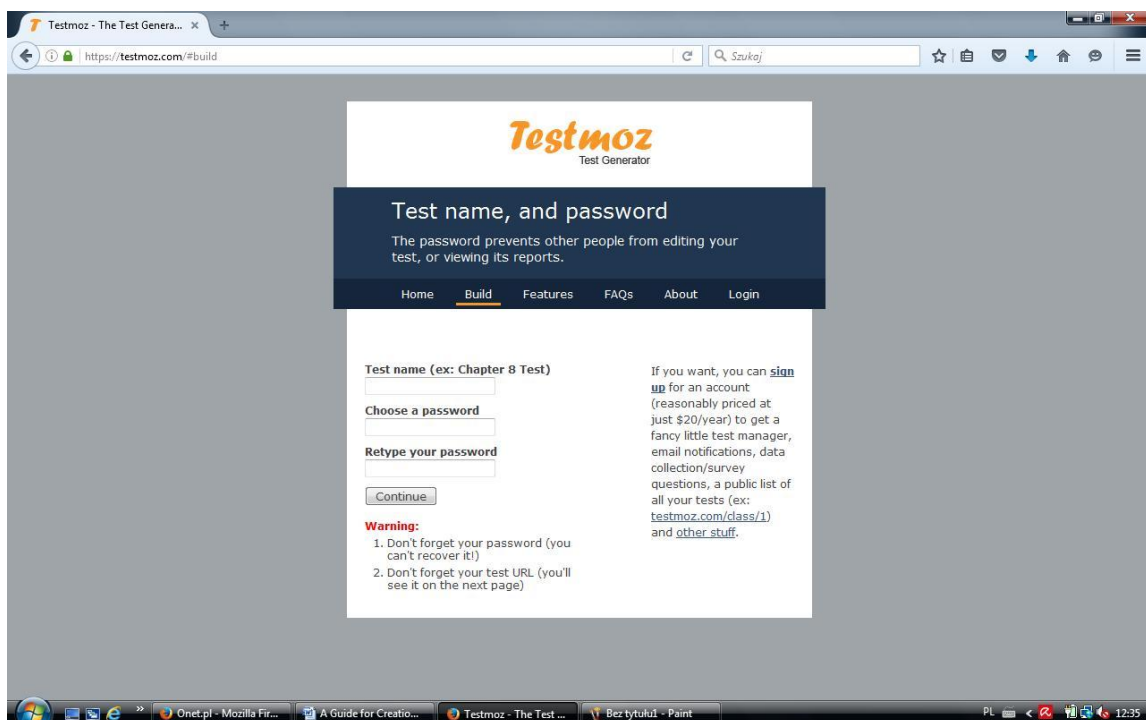
Step 1

- Enter the website address: testmoz.com



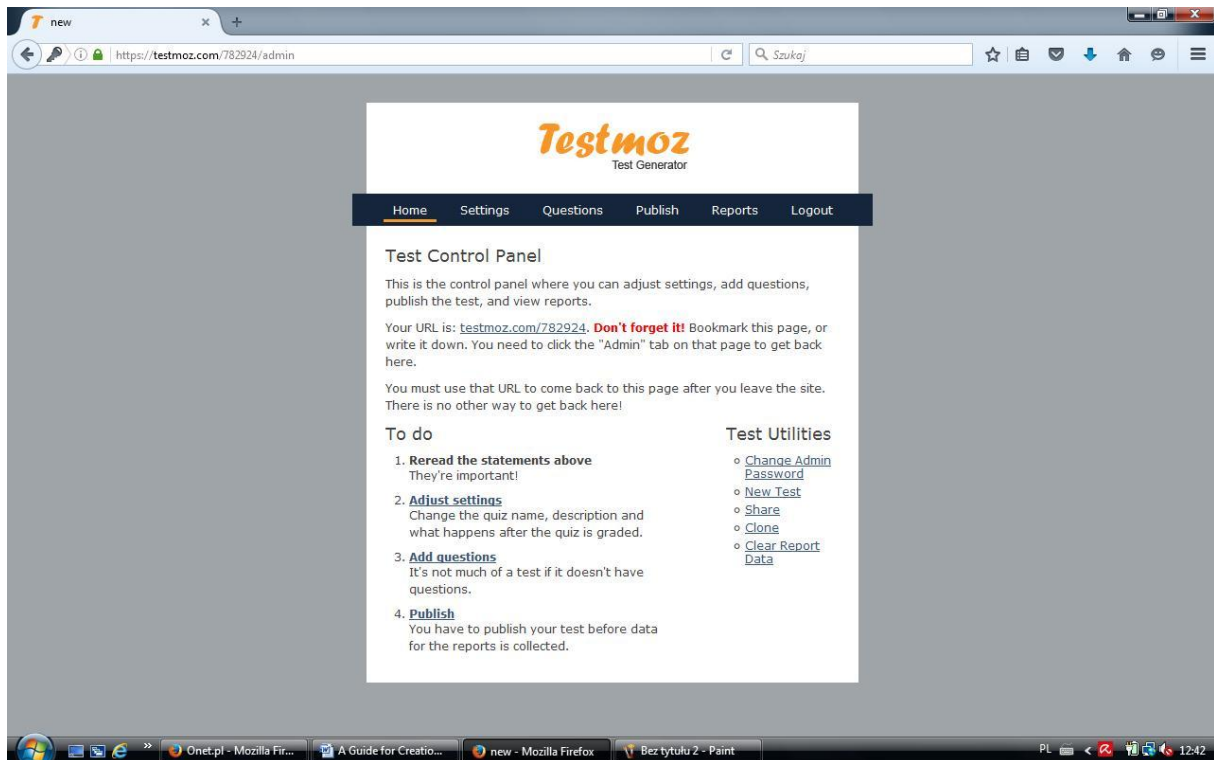
Step 2

- Click on 'make a test', choose the test title and your password, you need to retype it and click 'continue'. You need to remember your test title and the URL, which you will see on the next page. URL is also crucial for the students to take the test, you just forward the URL to your students and they need to login as a student.



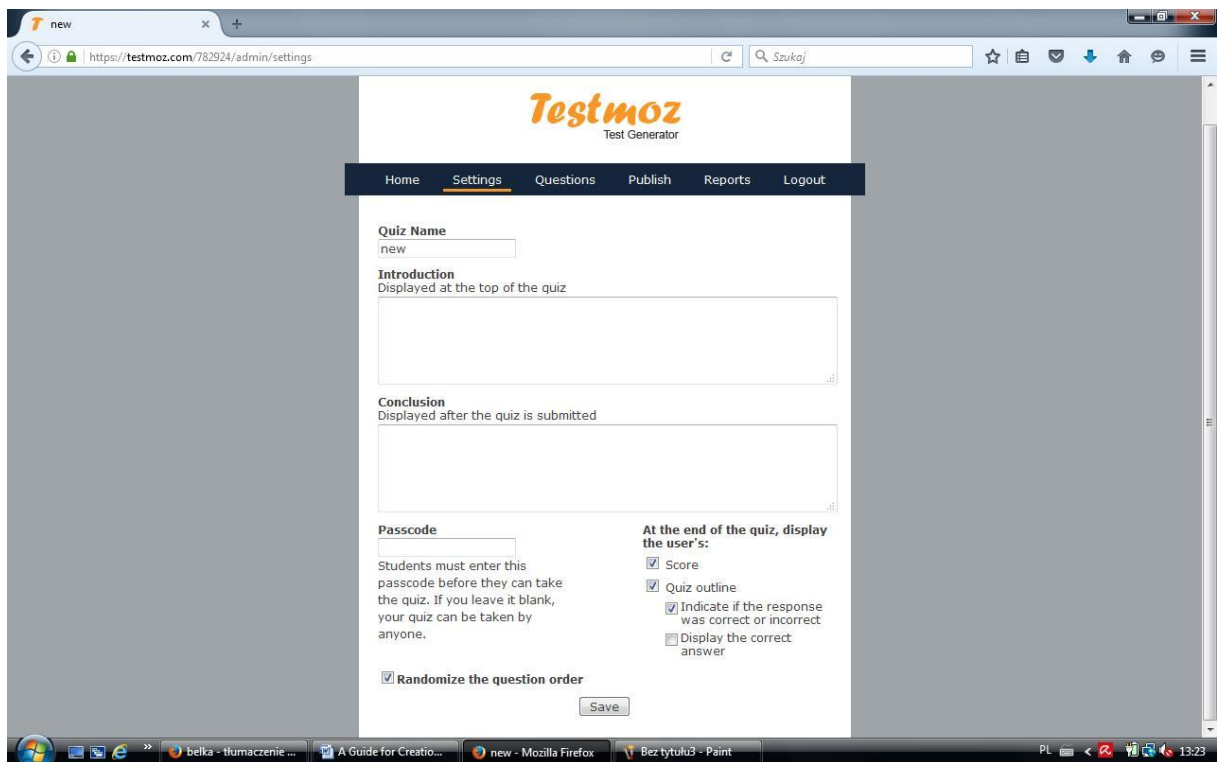
Step 3

- At this stage, you can prepare the test. It is very important to write down or bookmark your URL, otherwise you will not be able to adjust or edit your test later on. This test generator is intuitive, therefore very easy to use. All you need to do is follow the instructions. The top bar, which contains settings, questions, publish and reports sections, allows to navigate the whole process.



Step 4

- In this part, you can type in the introduction and conclusions sections (this enables you to forward and necessary information to you students). There is also a **'postcode'** section, it is best to leave it blank, so that anyone can take the test. In the bottom right corner there is a **'At the end of the quiz, display the user's '** section. There are four boxes (Score, Quiz outline, Indicate if the response was correct or incorrect, Display the correct answer), which you can tick to your expectations accordingly. You can also tick **'Randomize the question order'** box. You need to save your settings. This will take you to the *questions page*.



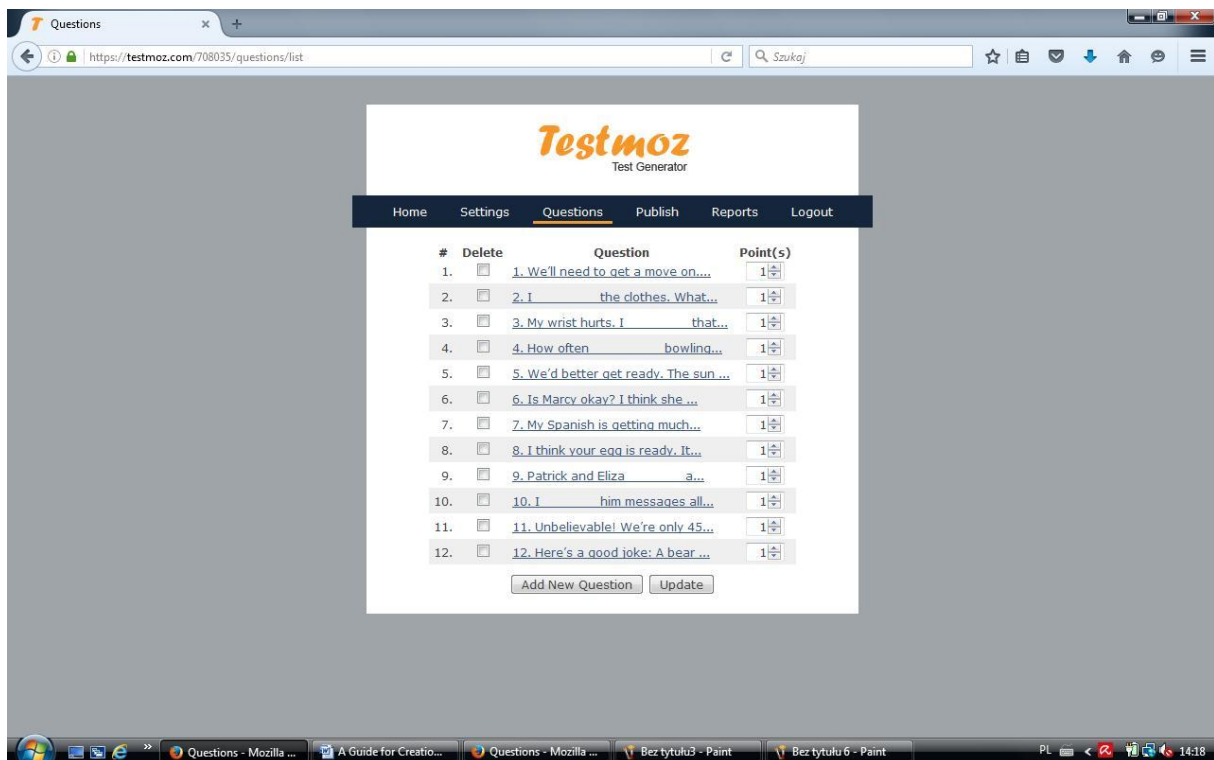
Step 5

- Click **'add new questions'** and you can start preparing the proper test.
 - *enter* the questions (you can copy –paste the questions from other tests)
 - *choose* the type of questions (true / false, multiple choice, multiple response or fill in the blank)
 - *enter* the answer choices, and mark which answer is correct (you can add or remove answer choice)
 - *add* the number of points for each question
 - *save* and add new questions, once you have finished, save the test (left bottom corner)



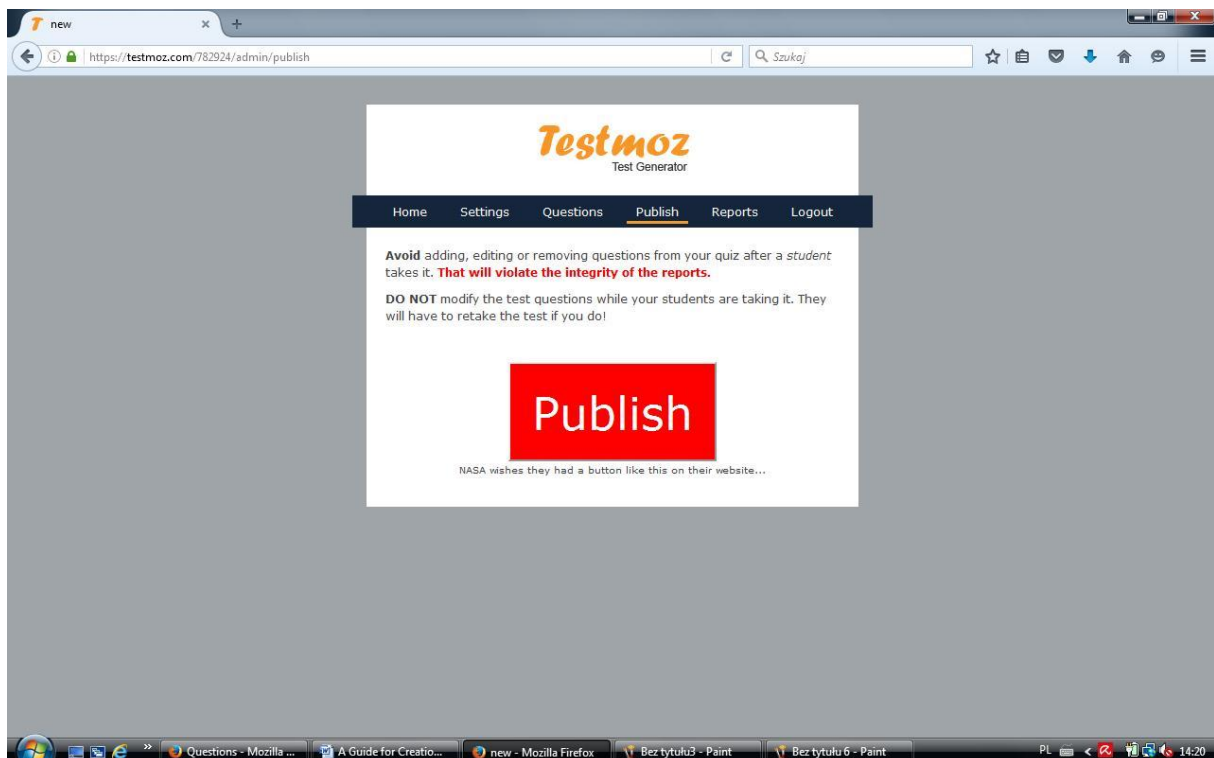
Step 6

- You can edit, add or remove your questions at any time.



Step 7

- In order to enable all your students to take the test, you need to publish it (top bar).



Step 8

- In the reports section you can find the scores of your students with their names and times spent on taking the tests. In the reports you can also find the average times and scores, but also a view of all individual students and the possible most problematic questions.
