The survey was divided in three parts. In the first part, we wanted to know about the programme in general. The second section was dedicated to the aims of the meeting and in which way they were reached. In the third part, we asked for an overall evaluation and asked for comments. To fill in the survey it took about 10 to 15 minutes.

All in all, 37 teachers took part in our survey which is a substantial number. Teachers from all the partner countries participated. To sum the results up quickly, we can say that nearly all the teachers thought that the meetings were well organized. According to the results, teachers would like to have more influence on the programme of the meeting. Most of them were very satisfied with the accommodation and the working sessions.

The participating teachers learned a lot about other European countries and most of them would like to participate in an Erasmus+ project again. Teachers learned most about new teaching techniques and ICT skills, but also improved their English and project management skills. The meetings helped most teachers in their professional development and was very useful in their everyday teaching. The working activities could be improved and sometimes the programme timing could be improved because of long waiting times. The most interesting part for most of the teachers was the cultural programme and getting to know different school systems and schools in foreign countries.

One comment concerned the level of English of some few participants. So maybe, the schools should make sure that every participant has an adequate level of English. But in general, the comments at the end of the survey were very positive, so we can say that the teachers enjoyed participating in the project, got lots of new ideas for teaching, improved their ICT skills, enjoyed the cooperation and management experience and would like to participate again in other European projects.
