NON FORMAL LEARNING: SCAVENGER HUNTS

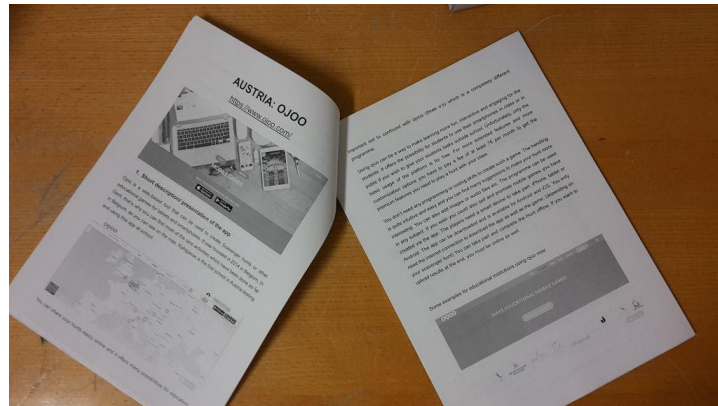

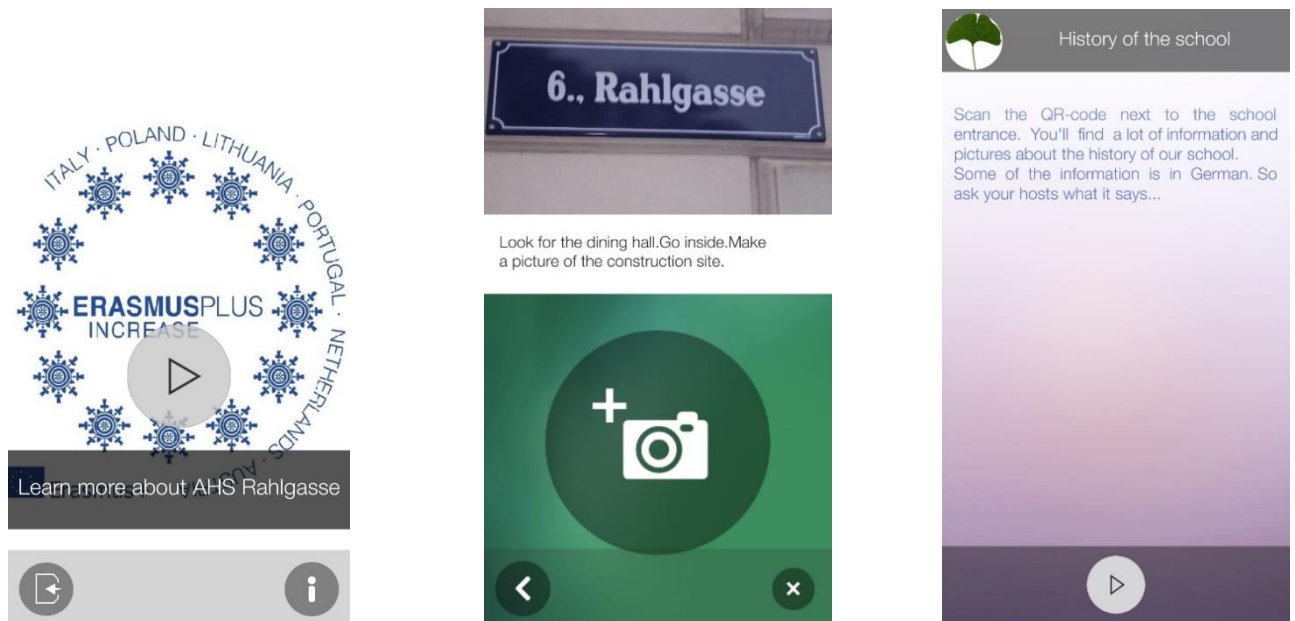
